Road Closures

In order to keep downtown safe for event participants, some road closures will be necessary. Please see the following list of closures, and contact the event organizer if you have any questions. Please visit www.junejubilee.com for more information about the entire weekend.

South Street - Closed from Park St. to Farmer' s Alley from Friday at 6 a.m. – Saturday at 7 p.m.

Please note the following:

- **Friday, June 1:** South St. will be closed beginning at 6 a.m. to accommodate Art on the Mall, organized by the Arts Council of Greater Kalamazoo.
- **Saturday, June 2:** South St. will remain closed through 5 p.m. to accommodate the KIArts Fair in Bronson Park, organized by the Kalamazoo Institute of Arts.
- **Roads will reopen:**
 - South St. from Park St. to St. Johns will reopen to traffic at 5 p.m.
 - South St. from St. Johns to Farm er's Alley w ill reopen to traffic at 7 p.m.

PLEASE NOTE: Access to Peregrine Towers and the Miller Canfield parking structures will be maintained. Signs will indicate what portion of the road is open for parking structure access only - NO STREET PARKING WILL

BE PERMITTED. Left turn access onto South St will be for Miller Canfield and Peregrine Towers only.

Kalamazoo Mall – Closed from Michigan Ave. to Lovell St. from Friday at 6 a.m.
– Saturday at 7 p.m.

- **Friday, June 1:** The Kalamazoo Mall will be closed beginning at 6 a.m. to accommodate Art on the Mall, organized by the Arts Council of Greater Kalamazoo.
- **Saturday, June 2:** The Kalamazoo Mall will remain closed through 7 p.m. to accommodate Art on the Mall, organized by the Arts Council of Greater Kalamazoo

Do-Dah Parade

- **Saturday, June 2:** The Do-Dah Parade Route is the same as previous years and is as follows: starting at the intersection of Portage and Lovell, West on Lovell, North on Park, East on W. Michigan, and South on Portage to Lovell. These roads will be closed from 10 a.m. – 1 p.m.

The following road closures will be in effect between 8 a.m. and 1 p.m. for staging the Do-Dah Parade, organized by Kalamazoo Experiential Learning Center: Portage Road between Lovell and the Portage-Pitcher Connector, Jasper Street between Lovell and Walnut, Lovell St. between Portage St. and Pitcher.
