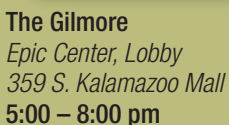
Madison Memering, a senior at the WMU Gwen Frostic School of Art, uses different mediums and techniques to explore nature and elements of wildlife.



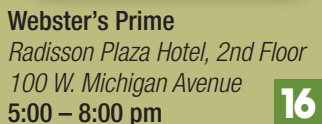

Jermeay Smith's work focuses on digital illustrations and paintings with a vector style to capture the less ordinary.



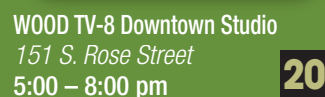
Pianist Anthony Healy, teaches music education at WMU and gives lessons through the Gilmore Education Department. Don't miss his solo piano performance at Art Hop.
